Statutory Consultation proposing to Establish a New Non-Denominational Primary School and Implement Catchment Changes to Address School Capacity and Accommodation Pressures in West Edinburgh

I am writing to let you know that a statutory consultation on the above proposal commences today Monday 26 August 2019 and will run until 5 pm on Monday 7 October 2019.

The proposals in the statutory consultation paper affect the catchment boundaries of Corstorphine Primary School, Cramond Primary School, Hillwood Primary School, Craigmount High School and The Royal High School.

A detailed summary of the proposals is provided in the attached document including maps illustrating the catchment changes.

Following the conclusion of the consultation period a report on the Outcomes of the Consultation will be presented to the Council in March 2020 and the report will be made publicly available three weeks before the Council meeting. Further details of this process are contained in the full statutory consultation paper.
