
The '20 Minute Neighbourhood' principles that our project can support are to improve:






What are SUDS?

Sustainable Urban Drainage systems collect rainwater and reduce the amount of water running directly into storm drains.

Why are SUDS good?

- They help in reducing flooding and drains from overflowing.
- They improve amenity and biodiversity; they can help to create habitat space for wildlife.




ROUTES & CONNECTIONS - MAPPING OF OPPORTUNITIES

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MASTERPLAN NOTES:

Enhance the streets:

- Reduce car dominance.
- Green the five internal streets.
- Intorduce new materials to the streetscape.
- Incorporate rain gardens and tree planting.
- Include gateway/ wayfinding features to enahnce sense of place.
- Add play opportunites along the routes.

Courtyards with car parking:

- Reduce car dominance.
- Green the courtyards.
- Introduce new materials to the courtyards.
- Include space for new use and activity that would benefit resident's needs.
- New uses like;
 - Communal raised planters.
 - Space to sit, socialise and enjoy nature.
 - Space to play.

Green courtyards:

- Introduce new uses and activity.
- Improve natural surveillance.
- Encourage social interactions. The proposals include;
 - Play areas.
 - Ball courts.
 - Fruit trees.
 - Spaces to sit and enjoy nature.

Biodiversity:

- SuDs
- Meadow
- Bulb planting Trees and new planting.
- Ecological features
- Space to enjoy nature. Enhance existing green spaces.

The Central Greenway:

- Establish better pedestrian, wheeled and active travel connections to the wider area beyond.
- Increase provision, uses and activity.
- Improve natural surveillance and potential for social interaction.

New uses & Activity:

- Increased and enhanced MUGAs/ Ball Courts.
- Skate area.
- Wheeled track.
- Play space through the estates.
- Central Greenway Play Space delivered by South West Edible Estates.
- Outdoor gyms/ trim trails.
- Space to grow food.
