The City of Edinburgh Council is consulting on design proposals to replace the current Liberton High School with a new building on the same site at 328 Gilmerton Road.

The new building will have capacity for approx 1200 pupils and will also incorporate a community cafe, community library, dance and fitness spaces, GP practice, Police Scotland workspace, flexible work-space for council partners and a variety of meeting spaces for the whole community.

The existing sports block, extended in 2016, is to be retained and the site masterplan includes a zone for potential location of a new Gaelic Medium Secondary school, should the council decide to build it in Liberton in the future.

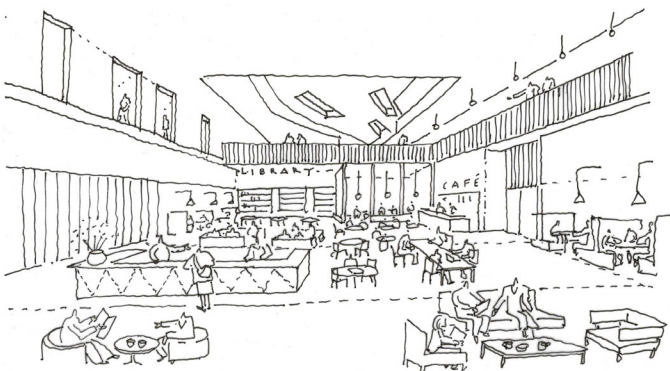
Public Drop In Events
