
#### **Proposed City Plan 2030**

City Plan 2030 has been approved by the City of Edinburgh Council Planning Committee and was submitted for examination in December 2022.






Local Plan Proposals Map

We want to hear what you think...


As part of the process, we want to hear what you think Seafield should become in the future. We are asking your views at three stages. These are illustrated below.
